We have often shared with you the highs and lows of life here in Tanzania and we are so grateful that you listen to both sides of the story. Once again, we have highs and lows to share..... in July, we celebrated Caedmon's graduation from Rift Valley Academy in Kenya. Then we reached a new "high"-- Mt. Kilimanjaro, at 19,341 feet! In celebration of his high school graduation, the family climbed to the top of Africa. We were above the clouds

for 6 days and it was a remarkable adventure....

Our newest video: [watch at https://vimeo.com/726316951] A Maasai premature baby girl, whose family initially refused transfer from their rural hospital to our NICU in Arusha. Every baby deserves the opportunity to go home with the mother.
