


Giving thanks for a joyous and generous Advent and Christmas!

First Lutheran is always a busy place, but particularly so from mid-November through the end of December each year. We hold additional seasonal worship services and host a number of concerts and events by outside groups as well. This was also our biggest Christmas Eve in at least 15 years, as we welcomed 418 worshipers (!) to our three candlelight communion services. Thanks to all who offered their time, talent and treasure to help us prepare for and celebrate the birth of Christ! Special thanks go to our worship leaders (acolytes, ushers, assisting ministers, lectors, communion set-up, altar guild, greeters, and all the rest!); to David Erickson and the Chancel Choir for a beautiful Lessons & Carols service; to all who helped set-up, cook, bake and/or serve food, and play music for Round-the-Tree; to poinsettia deliverers, cookie bakers and packers, proofreaders, Bell Choir ringers, decorators and greens-hangers, and everyone else who lent a hand—we couldn't do it without you!





What's next?



We have been enjoying our new and renovated space for a few months now, but as folks have noticed, we don't have **furniture for the upper level of the Atrium** yet! We wanted to wait to see the finished space and how people would move through and around it from the elevator and stairs to the various doors and hallways before we made decisions about seating groups and other furnishings. Our furnishings need to be easily rearranged/moved for events such as funeral visitations, durable, and cleanable, but also in keeping with the architecture of the space. We are consulting with a local designer for ideas and guidance.

In other news: As has been shared via several articles over the past few months, **the main door to the new addition** was not built and outfitted as designed and specified. The door is supposed to have automatic openers for accessibility, as well as panic bars, the ability to be programmed to be locked/unlocked at specific times, and compatibility with a fob system. Our architect is taking the lead on resolving this issue. We are keeping the temporary ramp in the stairwell by Pastor Leber's office in place because we expect there to be a short period of time sometime in the next few months when we will have to use that door as a temporary entrance again.

Finally, as planned, we will be converting our construction loan to a 20-year mortgage in mid-January 2020. This means we will transition from making interest-only payments to paying both interest and principal.

Please note that the church office will be closed on Monday, January 20, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr.'s birthday.






Congregation Council transition — 2020 Officers
