

Pastor Jacobs - 60th anniversary

Pastor Jacobs was ordained on June 14, 1961, at Trinity Lutheran Church, Arendtsville, Pennsylvania, after graduating that May from Gettysburg Lutheran Seminary (now United Lutheran Seminary). Just a week after ordination, Pastor Jacobs was installed at his first call, the "New Kingstown Charge" - St. Stephen's, New Kingstown and Mt. Zion, Allen. Pastor Jacobs also served calls to Calvary Lutheran, Dover, and St. Peter's Lutheran, Middletown, before being called to our congregation in 1977.

Pastor Jacobs served First Lutheran for 24 years, retiring in 2001. There are many folks still at First Lutheran who were baptized, confirmed and/or married by him! Pastor Jacobs also has been gracious in assisting us with our quarterly healing services in recent years. Congratulations, Pastor Jacobs, and blessings to you and Janet as you celebrate this anniversary!





Pastor Lorenz - 40th anniversary

Pastor Lorenz was ordained on May 16, 1981, at the annual convention of the New Jersey Synod, in Ocean City, New Jersey, after graduating just a few days before from Philadelphia Lutheran Seminary (now United Lutheran Seminary). Pastor Lorenz's first call was to Jerusalem Lutheran Church, Sellersville, Pennsylvania. He also served calls to Resurrection Lutheran, Levittown, and St. Paul, New Cumberland, before becoming the senior pastor of Trindle Springs Lutheran, Mechanicsburg, in 2000. After his retirement from Trindle Springs in 2014, Pastor Lorenz and Marsha, his wife, joined First Lutheran. Since 2015, Pastor Lorenz has been serving as our congregation's "pastoral assistant" - we are very grateful for his preaching and visitation ministry!
