## To everything there is a season...



As we move into the fall season - the beginning of a new year of faith formation and the time of harvest, cooler weather, and changing leaves - as our choirs begin rehearsing and singing and ringing again and we start planning for Advent and Christmas (!) - we do find ourselves still in the season of construction. *Building to Serve All God's Children* has, indeed, taken much longer than we anticipated, for a variety of reasons. We have done our best to keep you updated through the *First Edition* and bulletins over these past eleven months. Thank you for your continuing patience and understanding as we have worked through challenges.

Because we are still under construction, we will be "easing" into the fall. While some activities will begin immediately (e.g., choirs, see p. 5, and some Sunday School classes), other activities, such as confirmation, will get a later start. We hope to be able to use our new nursery (upper level, former Youth Lounge) by mid-September. In the meantime, we are using one of the Head Start rooms under the sanctuary as a temporary nursery.

Please note that most, if not all, Sunday morning activities will take place on the upper level once our project is complete. Please also note our new Sunday morning schedule, effective Sunday, September 15:

# AUGUST COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Pastor Leber updated Council on the work of the Safety and Security Task Force as well as the *Building to Serve All God's Children* building project.
- Council set the date for the annual congregation meeting for Sunday, November 10, after the 10:30 a.m. service.

#### Safety and Security Update

The Safety and Security Task Force has recommended that, once construction is finished, the door on the east end of the Christian Education wing (currently used as our temporary weekday entrance) be kept locked at all times. The door will continue to have panic bars to provide emergency egress. Please help us maintain the safety of people in our building by making sure that doors and windows are secured when you leave the building, especially after evening meetings. Thank you!

# Building to Serve All God's Children Capital Campaign Update (as of August 25)

# Women of the Thankoffering and Ingathering Sunday October 6



Sunday, October 6, will be a special day, as we celebrate Thankoffering and Ingathering Sunday!

Thankoffering services have a long history in the Lutheran church, beginning in the late 19th century, when Lutheran women were given small Thankoffering boxes to place in a special location in their homes as a visible reminder of blessings received. Women would add coins to those boxes almost daily as particular blessings were noted. From their use came the idea of an annual church service to celebrate their collection.



During worship on October 6, we will also bless the quilts the women of First have made throughout the year and the school and personal care kits donated by the congregation. The kits and quilts will be delivered to Lutheran World Relief for distribution around the world.


