# Building to Serve All God's Children



August 29th was "Celebration Sunday," and we do have much to celebrate as we reflect on our very successful three-year capital campaign, concluded on May 31.

Between fulfilled and "over-fulfilled" pledges and unpledged/"as able" gifts, you can see below that we far exceeded the fundraising goal of \$600,000 set for our 2018-2021 campaign period!

Later this month, First Lutheran members and friends will be invited to make a commitment to a second three-year capital campaign. Because of your faithful giving and several legacy gifts, in the past three years since we broke ground on our construction/renovation project, we already have paid down a significant amount of the project cost. We are hoping that, by the end of a second campaign, in 2024, our principal balance will be further reduced, reducing our annual debt service as well.

### MASKS REQUIRED AT WORSHIP, EFFECTIVE SUNDAY, AUGUST 29

Unfortunately, the rate of transmission of COVID-19 in Pennsylvania, including Cumberland County, is high again these days, and even some vaccinated individuals are becoming infected. All worshippers (vaccinated or not) are required to wear masks while in the building on Sunday mornings. This requirement is consistent with current CDC guidance that, in areas of substantial or high transmission, masks should be worn by all in public indoor spaces. Hopefully, the surge caused by the Delta variant will soon peak, and we can relax the mask requirement in the not-too-distant future.

On Sunday morning, August 15, we noticed that our Nativity stained glass window had been broken! It appeared that someone had thrown an object hard enough to break through both the protective outside glass and the colored glass. The damage was reported to our insurance carrier, the Carlisle Borough Police, and Cumberland Stained Glass, the company which has restored our windows over the past 14 years.

We are grateful for how quickly Cumberland Stained Glass came to inspect the damage, provide an estimate, and set a date for the repair work.





# The good news...

is that, on Friday, August 27, Cumberland Stained Glass repaired the window beautifully (pictured above left, the artists at work!). The bottle pictured above right was found stuck between the protective glass and the stained glass and turned over to the police. Our insurance carrier was very responsive and has already issued payment to us for the repairs (minus our deductible).
