FIRST AID EQUIPMENT

Now that lots of events and activities have resumed in our building (which means that lots of folks are around!), a reminder that we have an automated external defibrillator (AED) in a central location on the upper level, the hallway between the nave and the Martin Luther Room. We also have first aid kits in several locations on both the lower and upper levels.

AEDs require bi-weekly or monthly monitoring with regular service and replacement of batteries, pads, etc. at certain intervals. Thanks to Marsha Lorenz who has been faithfully monitoring the AED and first aid kits since their placement in 2019.

A reminder: If there is a medical emergency in the building, call 911 FIRST.

Happy 45th Ordination Anniversary, Pastor Heintzelman!


Many of you have had the opportunity to meet the Rev. Sarah Heintzelman over the past few years since she began worshipping regularly with us. Pastor Heintzelman will be received into membership at First, along with several other folks, on Sunday, June 11.

Now that she is "one of ours", we have the honor of celebrating Pastor Heintzelman's 45th ordination anniversary (August 18, 1978) and will do so dur-

ing "Afters in the Atrium" following 10:30 a.m. worship on August 20.

Pastor Heintzelman began her church work in 1968 as a deaconess at Christ Lutheran, Harrisburg. In 1972, she began serving Trinity Luther-

an, Lemoyne, and St. Paul's Lutheran, New Cumberland (half-time at each). After U.S. Lutherans voted to ordain women to Word and Sacrament ministry in 1970, then-Sister Sarah began her studies at the Lutheran Theological School at Gettysburg (while still working!). She was ordained at Mt. Zion Lutheran, Boiling Springs, which she served from 1978-1990. Pastor Heintzelman also was pastor of Evangelical Lutheran, Mt. Holly (1990-93), and St. Matthias Lutheran, Carlisle, from which she retired in 2017.
