UPDATE ABOUT OUR CANTOR SEARCH

Unfortunately, we have not had <u>any</u> applicants for our part-time cantor position. There are fewer and fewer people choosing a career in church music these days, and a number of full- and part-time organist/minister of music positions are open in congregations in Central PA at this time, so, while this is disappointing, it is not entirely unexpected.

We are extremely blessed to have contracted with a substitute organist, David Binkley, for Lent, Holy Week and Easter Sunday. David served as Organist/Choirmaster at Camp Hill Presbyterian Church for 42 years from May of 1973 until his retirement in December of 2015. He is an honor graduate of Lebanon Valley College and received the Master of Sacred Music degree from New York City's Union Theological Seminary School of Sacred Music.

An active member of the American Guild of Organists and the Presbyterian Association of Musicians, David has played organ recitals and presented church music workshops throughout the Central PA area.

As our substitute organist, David will not be responsible for our choir program. At this time, the Bell Choir is on hiatus. We hope to provide opportunities for singers from the Chancel Choir to sing in a "pick up choir" at least a few times a month.

David is open to extending his contract into the season of Easter if our cantor position continues to remain open.

You were truly "little Christs" ministering to both of us with your compassion, caring, your cards and most of all, your prayer support.



END OF YEAR FINANCE REPORT

The Finance Committee wishes to thank the congregation for another tremendous year of financial support in 2021. In addition to the generous commitments you have made to our capital campaign, your regular offerings to our operating needs, benevolence and capital projects not only helped to support our ministries and keep our building operating, but provided an additional \$15,101 in benevolence support, locally and across the globe (detailed in the pie chart below).
